P.A.D.S. (Public Action to Deliver Shelter) is a not-for-profit network of organizations that provides emergency shelter, food and available resources to people who are homeless.

The P.A.D.S. Network operates throughout Northeastern Illinois including Southwest Chicago, Lake County, Elgin, South Suburban, McHenry County, DuPage County, Ottawa, Peru, Freeport, West Suburban, and Sterling.

P.A.D.S. provides numerous, specialized services, catering to the particular needs of their individual homeless populations. Transitional housing is another area in which the P.A.D.S. Network has excelled.

The staff collaborates with other agencies to provide services to their clients including financial management, employment retention and counseling services.

P.A.D.S. recognize the unmet need for transitional facilities for both men and women, and have worked to establish both types.
