As recorded in the original ledger (shown above), the company's first transaction was a mortgage loan made on March 28, 1855, to Edward Casey & Brothers in the amount of \$5,000 for a period of five years.

The property is described in the ledger as being located in the "Original Town" in Lot 6, Block 42 on Washington Street between Franklin and Market. This pre-fire map is adapted from the original Thompson Plat of 1830.

It is this transaction that now marks Baird & Warner's official "birthday." Although it is reasonable to presume that the enterprise itself was actually begun earlier that same year, no available records exist to definitively support this claim.
